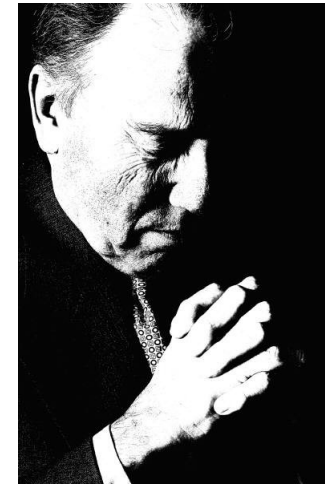

We already had a glider rocker and a small, carved desk in the room. She made a request that has developed into something wonderful. "Is there any way we could use the room for those needing a quiet place for prayer and reflection?" Soon after, her Pastor donated a stunning individual prayer kneeler, a cross, and a hymnal.

Upon hearing of our plans to create a prayer room, members of St. Rita's Church donated many other wonderful and inspiring items.

The son of another resident informed me the church where he is employed was giving away pews that were taking up storage space. They were just gorgeous, with the extra seating providing an even larger area outside the Prayer Room to accommodate Communion and Rosary services. The residents would now have a serene location to pray without being disturbed by the ringing of phones and doors opening and closing. We are also very fortunate to incorporate our organ, which is now located in the larger prayer area.

Yet another family became involved in the development of this wonderful new addition to our community. In memory of one of our former residents, a beautiful bookcase and two very special, large print bibles were donated.

It is with great pleasure we dedicate the Sage Harbor Prayer Room to all of our residents - past, present, and future. May all those who spent time here feel the love and care that went into creating a place for anyone, of any faith to pray and enjoy a bit of peace and serenity.
